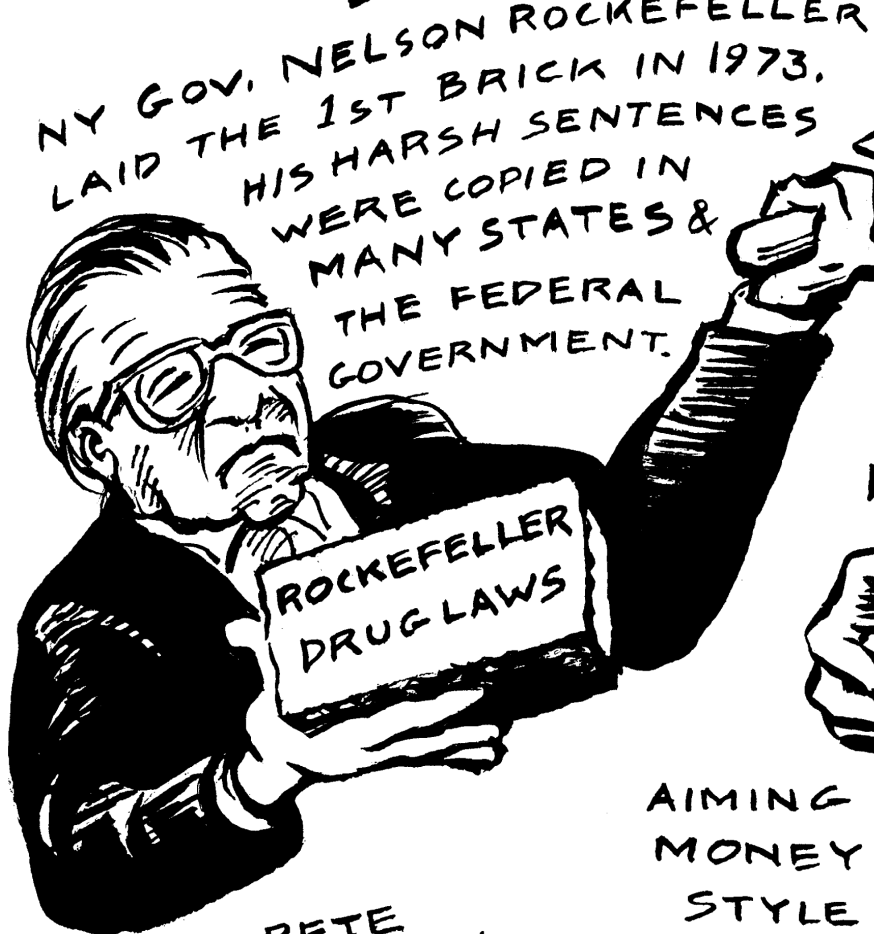
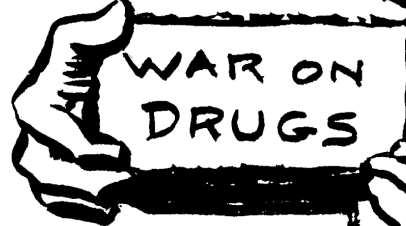


MEET THE BUILDERS OF THE DRUG PRISON BOOM
