As many of you know, on June 14th oral arguments happened in my case before the Oregon Supreme Court concerning my transfer to Florida under the Interstate Corrections Compact (ICC). Another Oregon prisoner, housed in Colorado, had his case consolidated with my case for arguments.

I wasn't able to watch the hearing, but for those of you who were able to watch it on the web, please let me know what you think.

My attorney called to speak to me today and gave me a run down of how the arguments went. She felt they went especially well and feels that the court's decision will be in my favor.

After speaking to my attorney and getting her assessment of the arguments I feel really positive about what the decision will likely be.

However, it could be anywhere from 90 days to 1 year before the court issues a written decision. So, it's a waiting game again.

In any case, I'm in the home stretch.

I want to thank everyone for their support. Keep me in your prayers and pray for a good solid decision that secures basic civil rights.
