

Update: November 16, 2015

As I previously let everyone know the Oregon Court of Appeals had ruled in my favor in a case over my confinement in the FDOC.

The case was on the verge of being sent back to the trial court and the ODOC filed a last minute appeal to the Oregon Supreme Court.

This will further delay my release from the FDOC and return to Oregon.

It turns out it is not only my case but another prisoners decided shortly after mine. The Oregon Attorney General stated in a recent motion:

"Due to the significance of the issues presented in Mr. Barrett's habeas litigation, the Appellate Division of the Oregon Department of Justice has made the decision to petition the Oregon Supreme Court for review."

Hopefully the Oregon Supreme Court will refuse to hear the cases. If not, this will impact a lot of folks whichever way it goes.
